

#PSCOCCHAT - 2nd or 3rd Monday of


#PSCOCCHAT stands for "Professional School Counselors of Color" (anyone can join the chat


#ESCCHAT - 2nd of 4th Thursday of the Month -8PM EST




Email the link Doodle gives you to your friends and their names automatically populate the participants section. It's easy for friends to fill out the form since all they do is put a check next to dates/times that work.

Caught In The Middle School

We are absolutely at a loss at my school and could use any and all advice . We have a student, 8th grade, we will call D. He was born drug addicted to an addict mother who was classified as "mentally retarded" and was also a prostitute and promptly gave him up. He has a multitude of diagnoses and problems that are too lengthy to even discuss . He's in our CDC class.

When he was in 6th grade he would have massive outbursts almost daily . Cursing . Getting naked. Harming staff. Breaking and throwing things . Our assistant principal has had to have surgery because of him. It's almost like he enters a psychotic state. He snaps. Grins at you , and then loses it .

7th grade he only had one meltdown the entire year. We assumed it was due to knowing us and expectations but that's not the case . Now, we are back to it . It's been 6 weeks . We have tried rewards. Punishment . Rationality . Any and everything . He's threatening to stab and murder kids and staff . It is every single day . We are pulling staff out to restrain him, isolate him, he's breaking things.

We are absolutely exhausted and have no idea what to do.






